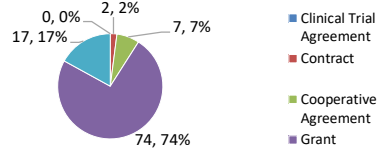

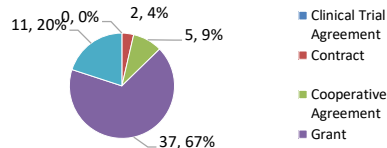

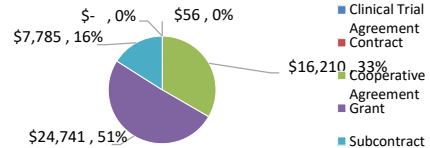
Proposals Processed by Activity Type



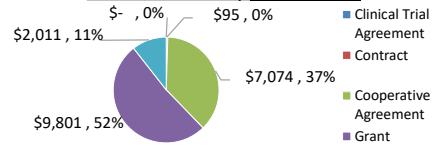
Awards Processed by Activity Type

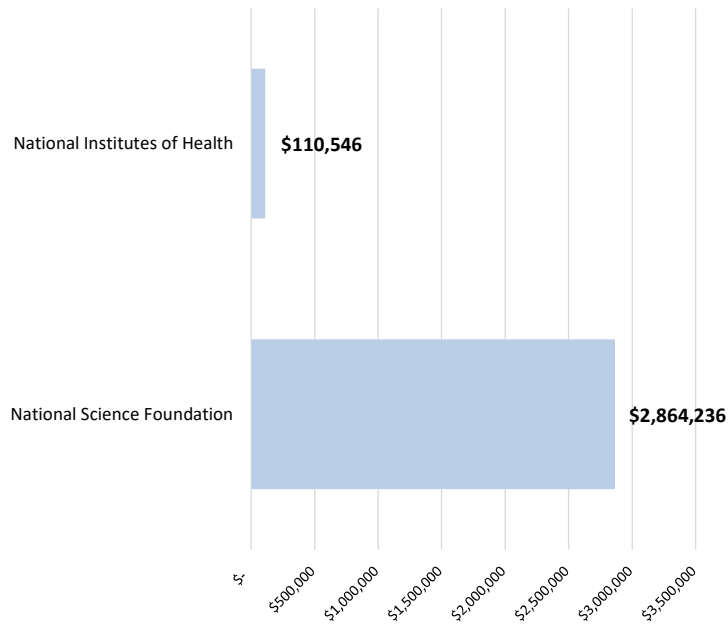

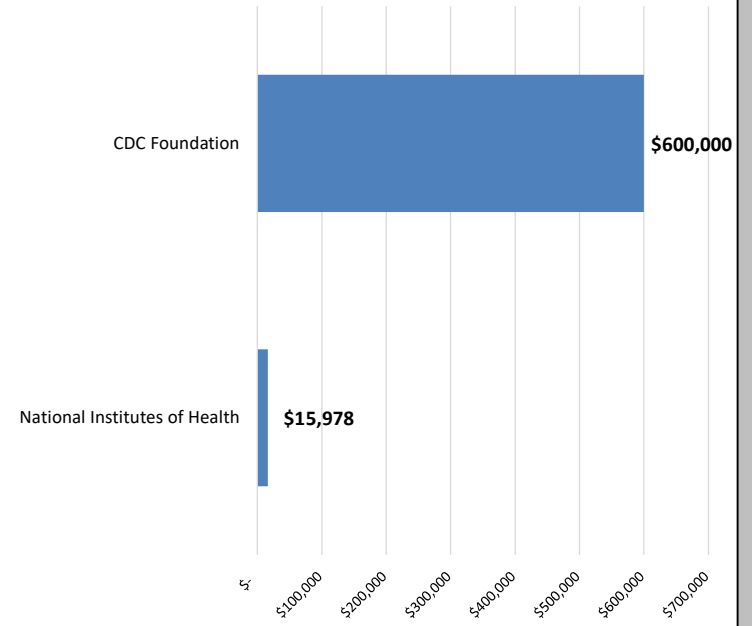

Funding Sources of COVID-19 Project Awards



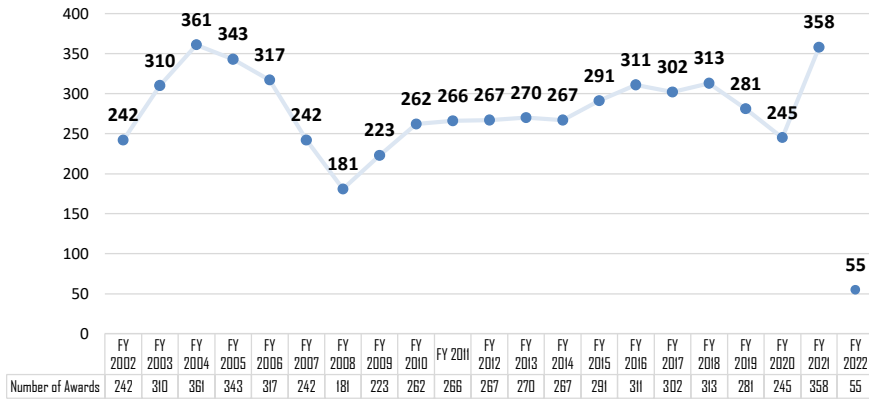

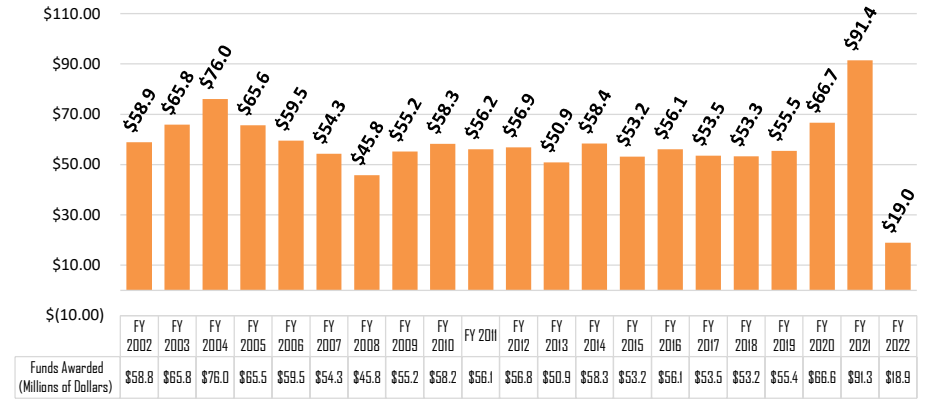
